## NEWS FROM THE SCIENCE LAB

Grades 6, 7 & 8:

St. Paul Middle School students had the exciting opportunity to be introduced to a 3D Printer. Mr. Bill Reeg, science teacher at St. Bruno's, instructed us on the ins and outs of the printer (XYZ printing da Vinci Mini). 3D printers use a computer program formatted design that translates into a 3D object using layers of polymer/plastic. Students are able to design their own object using a computer program. 3D printing is referred to as Additive Manufacturing (AM).
