MINISTRY UPDATES

- Clothing Share: Jerie Roder stated tons of donations were received for the free clothing exchange. The clothing share was busy and Jerie had plenty of volunteers to help clean up and drop off the remaining donated items to Saint Vincent DePaul in Waukesha.
- Heavenly Babies: Ann Krumrich set up a display for the Heavenly Babies ministry in the gathering space following masses one weekend in May to bring awareness to the Heavenly Babies ministry. 4 new volunteers signed up to help assemble layette bags and 1 new rummager to help acquire gently used baby clothing for the layette ministry.
- Peru: Deb Passino gave a brief overview of the Peru ministry which she has been involved with since 2013. Deb Passino and Lisa Bixby will travel on a mission trip to Peru July 10th – 19th. They welcome others to join them. Deb stated there is much damage to the local community where St. Clare school is located due to recent flooding. People have lost their homes and there is illness and death due to spread of disease. Deb spoke with the Sr. Monica, the director of the St. Clare school, to find out what are their greatest needs and how can St. Paul parish be of help. Needs discussed included:
Prayer network: St, Paul parishioners would be paired with families form the St. Clare school community. Pictures could be taken both here and there and given to the respective families partaking in the prayer network. The prayer network could link St. Paul school children and their families with student attending St. Clare school in Peru.
Water purification: Water purifiers needed more than ever with the recent flooding. 75 have been assembled and placed homes to date during previous mission trips to Peru. Deb is hoping to place 50 – 75 more into operation during her visit to Peru in July. Each purifier costs \$100.00. Some money has been raised to date and Deb is hoping to raise the remainder prior to her visit there in July.
Other needs include a new or used vehicle for the sisters to carry out their work in the community. Current vehicle is very old and often in need of repair. Deb proposed to idea of raising money to use as a down payment on a vehicle, allowing for a reduced monthly payment. Estimated vehicle cost would be around \$16,000.00.
Emergency Medical Fund: Deb suggested creating a fund that could be used toward medical needs. Many people in the local community are poor and don't have money to seek medical attention when needed. This fund could be used to help offset the cost of physician visits, prescriptions and other medical needs.
Deb is looking for ideas for a fundraiser to raise money to help support one/some of the above needs.
Future goals: A portion of the annual Human Concerns Lenten collection will go toward supporting the ongoing water purification project in Peru. A medical mission trip is slated for the summer of 2019.

FINANCIALS:

Casa Maria groceries, St. Ben's groceries, and Easter Food Drive purchased from funds for Loaves and Fishes Peru \$2000 donation to help with flooding
